BYLAW 2013-03**

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Town of Craik
in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:

- (a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
- (b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
- (c) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Craik.

2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with the rates contained within the Fire Protection Agreement which may be revised from time to time.

3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 30 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
