SOLID WASTE COLLECTIONS AND DISPOSAL CHARGES

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL CHARGES ON SOLID WASTE

1. SHORT TITLE

The Bylaw may be cited as the "Rates Bylaw".

2. PURPOSE

To provide waste collection, rates and fees for the collection and disposal of solid waste.

The Council of the Town of Craik in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. A charge shall be established, as set out in Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw, for the collection of solid waste from all properties in the Town of Craik. Such Charges shall be included in the Quarterly residential utility bills and commercial/industrial monthly utility bills sent out to all properties.
2. All properties must have 2 bins, one for solid waste and one for recyclable materials collected and disposed of by Loraas Disposal contracted by the Town of Craik.
3. The charges shall be billed to the property owner or occupant who receives the service.

This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
