

BYLAW NO. 2018-12

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CRAIK TO PROVIDE FOR THE SECURITY OF THE WATER TREATMENT AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS WITHIN THE TOWN OF CRAIK

COUNCIL of the *Town of Craik*, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the **Water Security Bylaw**

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to allow only authorized personnel to have access to the facilities and all other parts pertaining in any way to the water treatment and distribution system within the Town of Craik.

Definitions

“Administrator”- Administrator of the Town of Craik

“Authorized Staff”-Members of the staff employed by the Town of Craik specifically authorized by the Administrator to access water treatment and distribution system

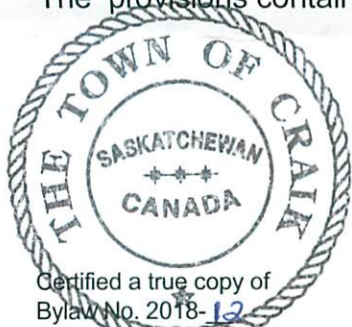
“Authorized Personnel”- professional workers authorized by the Administrator, individuals authorized to act on the behalf of companies contracted to perform services directly related to the water treatment and distribution systems

“Government Officials” –officials of the federal or provincial governments whose mandates require that they have access to the water treatment and distribution system


“Casual Visitors”- individuals who are authorized on a case by case basis to enter the water treatment or distribution facilities

4. All facilities are to be locked at all times with access being restricted to authorized individuals only
5. No individual is permitted to enter any water treatment or distribution facility without proper authorization
6. All authorized personnel must report to the Administrator before accessing any water treatment or distribution facility.
7. Casual visitors require written authorization on a case-by-case basis from the Administrator. In the absence of the Administrator, written authorization from the Mayor is required. Casual visitors must be accompanied by the licensed operator at all times when present in water treatment or distribution facilities,
8. Any individual entering a water treatment or distribution facility in contravention the terms of this bylaw will be subject to a charge of trespassing.
9. A copy of this bylaw is to be posted at the entrance to any and all water treatment or distribution facilities.

The provisions contained in this bylaw shall come into force upon adoption of the bylaw
