To Whom It May Concern

Bylaw 9/94 was passed unanimously on July 5, 1994 and consists of the following stipulations for burials in the new section of Craik Cemetery:

1. The base of each headstone must be countersunk and flush with the ground.
2. Headstones resting on the base can be a maximum of 36" in length and a maximum of 16" in height.
3. Once the headstone is placed, there must be a minimum of 3 ½" apron, flush with the ground. That is, the base must be at least 3 ½" larger than then headstone on all sides for the purpose of upkeep.
4. Grave covers are not allowed.
5. That in case of cremation, the maximum is four burials per plot.
6. The purchaser of each plot will be given 3 letters, outlining the duties of the purchaser, the digger and the monument installer. It is the purchaser's responsibility to distribute these letters to the appropriate parties.
7. The Town of Craik takes no responsibility for monuments that do not adhere to this Bylaw and will notify the purchaser if and when there exists non-compliance.

Plots are to be dug as outlined on the following attachment so as to keep the rows and columns straight and neat. Care must be taken when installing headstones to ensure the row is even and straight, otherwise, it may be necessary to redo the job.
