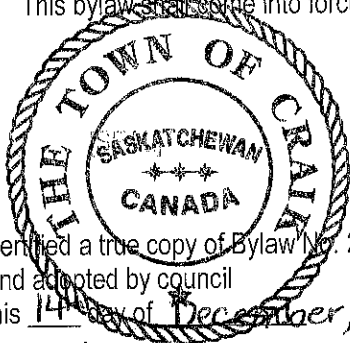

Bylaw No. 2016-13
A BYLAW TO CONTROL SNOW DUMPING


The Council of the Town of Craik, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Dumping of snow is prohibited anywhere other than on private property within the Town of Craik.
2. Pushing snow off private property onto roadways is not allowed.
3. Section 1 notwithstanding, snow may be dumped at designated sites as indicated in Appendix A.
4. Persons using designated snow dumping sites are responsible for ensuring that the snow does not contain any harmful or prohibited material.
5. Snow dumped on private property must not interfere with, cause flooding, or otherwise damage or interfere with adjacent properties.
6. Any person dumping snow on private property shall be liable for any damage caused to other properties as a result of said dumping.
7. Any violation of any portion of this bylaw shall result in the imposition of the following fines:
 - a. First offence \$75.00
 - b. Second offence \$150.00
 - c. Third offence \$300.00
8. This bylaw shall come into force and become effective immediately.
