


TOWN OF CRAIK
BYLAW NO. 2016-15
A BYLAW TO CONTROL ACCESS TO THE LAGOON

The Council of the Town of Craik, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Dumping of sewage and waste water is prohibited anywhere within the Town of Craik.
2. Access to the wastewater lagoon (hereinafter referred to as the Lagoon) owned and operated by the Town of Craik shall be restricted to those individuals or businesses authorized by the Council of the Town of Craik.
3. Section 2 notwithstanding, those individuals so authorized by law or regulations of the Government of Canada or the Government of Saskatchewan shall have full and unfettered access at any time.
4. Individuals seeking to dump in the Lagoon requires a permit issued by the Administrator of the Town of Craik (hereinafter referred to as the Administrator) or his or her designate and to undertake a commitment in writing to refrain from dumping any harmful or prohibited material.
6. Fees for dumping by individuals shall be \$25 per dump.
7. Commercial enterprises seeking to dump require a permit issued by resolution of Town Council.
8. Commercial entities seeking a permit to dump shall be required to undertake a commitment in writing to refrain from dumping any harmful or prohibited material
9. Fees for dumping by commercial entities shall be issued on a quarterly basis and shall be as follows
 - a. 20 dumps or less per quarter \$150.00 per quarter
 - b. 21 to 40 dumps per quarter \$300.00 per quarter
 - c. a commercial entity that during the quarter anticipates exceeding its limit shall notify the Administrator who at his or her discretion may assess an additional fee.
10. A commercial permit may be cancelled at any time by simple resolution of Town Council.
11. Any violation of any portion of this by law shall result in the imposition of the following fines:
 - a. First offence \$300.00
 - b. Second offence \$500.00
 - c. Third offence \$750.00

12. This bylaw shall come into force and become effective on April 30, 2017.
