Town of Craik SIGN CORRIDORS Bylaw # 2017-03

A Bylaw of the Town of Craik in respect to regulating signs and billboards with sign corridors administered by the Town of Craik for the purpose of promoting tourism and economic development.

- 1) The Council of the Town of Craik in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

 Signs located in the Craik Sign Corridors are required to comply with "The Erection of Signs Adjacent to Provincial Highways Regulations, 1986".
- 2) The Town shall act as administrator of the sign corridor. An application is required to place a sign in the sign corridor.
- 3) As administrator of the sign corridor, the Town shall be responsible to approve all signs prior to installation, ensuring all signs meet with the Standards as set by the Department of Highways.
- 4) All signs located in the highway sign corridor shall adhere to the Town of Craik sign corridor 'regulations' and sign 'specifics' to create an aesthetically pleasing sign and sign corridor.
- 5) Government signs, memorial signs and directional signs that bear no advertising including traffic control, no trespassing, hunting restriction and similar signs are exempt from restrictions.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of final-passing
